An interesting account was given by Evan Means of the Symposium at which seven were registered from Tennessee.

July 14 was set as a trail maintenance work day in Catoosa Wildlife Management Area. It was explained that although this is not an ideal time weatherwise, it would avoid the hunting seasons.

Bob Brown suggested that we work toward the establishment of the Natchez Trace Scenic Trail, which has been included in the National Trails Act for study. He also proposed the inclusion of a horse trail and a bicycle trail as this trail would lend itself more appropriately than many of the other parts of the Cumberland Trail and other trails already established as hiking trails.
