The president, David Stidham, reminded the members to tie in the 1986 hike schedule with Homecoming 1986.

Evan Means said he had not yet had time to consult with Grimes Slaughter on the status of Section II of the Cumberland Trail, which TTA has agreed to maintain.

Annual meeting plans were discussed. Evelyn Tretter, chairman of host chapter, Nashville, said that beds need to be reserved by Sept. 7, meals by Sept. 27. A motion was passed to donate the proceeds of the auction to be held at the annual meeting to promoting the Cumberland Trail. The CT will be the theme of the annual meeting.

Recipients of the TTA Award and the Bill Stutz Award were selected. These will be announced at the annual meeting.

Evan Means reported that royalties on his book "Tennessee Trails were \$209.87 for the first half of 1985. Means donates these royalties to TTA. A total of 5658 copies of the book have been sold.

Means said the annual meeting of the National Trails Council and an International Trails Symposium will be held in 1986 at Vancouver, British Columbia, at the time of Expo '86

It was pointed out that the state of Oregon has passed land use laws. Bertha Chrietzberg suggested that TTA promote such laws for Tennessee. Evelyn Tretter will write for information on Oregon's laws.
