Treasurer's report - Kathy Woods

A financial report was sent out prior to meeting < attached >. A new report showing month by month income and expenses was circulated and well received; Kathy may continue this reporting quarterly. TTA received several donations in memory of Columbia/Franklin chapter member John Dillon. TTA's and CTC's annual audit has been completed and was circulated for filing to TTA's Treasurer, Secretary, President and CTC office.

Membership report - Tim Townley

A membership report was circulated prior to meeting < attached >. The purpose for wanting to know when a member became a Lifetime member was to have a precise record of each amount that went into making each CD. TTA has no intention of touching the principal of the CD. Interest earned on the CD was decided years ago to help provide operating expenses but here recently the interest amounts have been pretty low. Annual Meeting Summary - Doug Burroughs

Sixteen hikes were planned for the entire weekend but 3 of these were cancelled.

151 is the combined total of pre-registered and walk-up attendees. Of the 151, 6 were absent, 12 were guests. Monies collected* registration is \$4,865; t-shirts is \$534; Evan Means donations \$

Communication/Enhancement donations \$562; money donations from 3 chapters totaled \$650; live auction \$1,245; silent auction \$1,528; white elephant \$312.75; cash bar \$455.10; bake sale \$265.60; personal donations \$110. (*these are gross amounts as expenses such as MBSP catering/facilities bill had not arrived.)

TTA/CTC Update - Carolyn Miller

Based on the discussion regarding the IRS' 990 form "Return of Organization Exempt From Income Tax," there are questions found in "Section B - Policies," and to be sure we have them, Nora Beck has offered to send a template of the various non-profit policies to Carolyn Miller, Kathy Woods, Diane Manas and Tim Townley, just in case we need them.

Gary Grametbauer, CTC's Chair, has been added as a signatory on CTC's activities.

The next CTC Board of Directors meeting is Saturday, December 6, 2014 in the Crossville area. The meeting is open to everyone. Carolyn will circulate a notice as soon as the time and location have been confirmed.

Regarding hiring a General Manager. No timeline or decision has been decided upon.

Del Truitt was introduced. He is the representative from the Friends of Cumberland Trail and made mention to watch their website for upcoming projects that need volunteers.

Our (CTC) relationship with TDEC & CTSP had reached a level of serious injury by the end of 2013 and it is really important that we get back on a positive track as we all have a goal of completing the CT.

Brock Hill of TDEC has approved our plans/leadership for Spring BreakAway, which will be March 8 through April 4,


3015 in Graysville at the Fort Bluff Camp there. We will be building new trail. Meals and lodging will be very close to the trail work site. Fort Bluff Camp is a Christian Camp with a strict no drugs/alcohol policy. They have a full kitchen and staff on hand to run it so we will not need cooks/dishwashers this year; however, any volunteer wishing to help around the camp is encouraged to let Carolyn know. Although Judy Varner resigned from CTC's Board, she has agreed to assist with Breakaway.

Bob Richards was commended for his trail maintenance and building sessions over the Annual Meeting weekend and provided a good introduction for working on any trail. One or a combination of chapters may wish to offer a trail training workshops with Bob before March/Breakaway (we could gain some trail "bosses" for Breakaway). The Black Mountain reroute is part of an HPP Grant that expires January 31, 2015. The Friends of CT may plan a work period to complete this before the deadline.

SWOT Follow Up - Bob Richards

SWOT is a process for strategic planning and an acronym for Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities, and Threats. Out of our last meeting, Bob circulated a report dated August 2, 2014 (it's in the packet of August 2 Board meeting minutes). The report identifies our Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities, and Threats and concluded that the CT is important to TTA and its volunteers, and that we need to move forward to develop a cohesive relationship with the personnel of TDEC and CTSP. During this Board meeting we focused on opportunities and communication. Bob will be sending an analysis of this meeting. But for now, here is a photo of the bullet points discussed:



Evan Means Small Grants Program - Bob Richards

Deadline for grants is December 31. The application can be found on TTA's website at: www.tennesseetrails.org/grants.php. Our budget for 2013 was \$5,000 (\$1,000 to CTC Breakaway; \$600 to Friends of Edgar Evins for signage; \$600 to Outdoor Encounter for tools to build a city trail in Thompson Station; \$600 to Uplands Village for tools to maintain a 7-mile trail in the Knoxville area); and allocating \$2,800. There is \$2,200 remaining in the budget for 2014.

National Trails Day - Bob Richards

NTD was successful in TN with 96 events and coming in at 4th in the Nation. Last year TN was 5th.

Request for Budget Items for 2015 - Carolyn Miller

On behalf of a request Fount Bertram made to Carolyn; asking for \$300 for SEFTC.

A motion was made by Joan Hartvigsen to increase the monthly stipend of our newsletter Editor from \$50 per month to \$100 per month, and receive a complimentary TTA membership for that year of service. Seconded by Cheryl Heckler. Motion passed.

Bob Richards is requesting TTA sponsorship for the April 15-17, 2015 TDEC Recreation Services Greenways & Trail Forum meeting at MBSP. This was tabled to the February 7, 2015 Board of Directors meeting.

TRAC - Bob Richards

Several Rail-Trails have opened and some are just getting started.

Shelby Farms (Memphis) Green Line has opened. Athens TN has opened 4.5 miles of rail-trail. Tweetsie Trail in Johnson City completed phase I which is 7 miles and recently opened. Tupelo Honey Restaurant/Café occupies the old train depot there. The Central Heritage Trail connecting Cookeville to Monterey does not have the trail into/from Monterey yet; however, the trailhead facilities are there. The Harahan Bridge project connecting Memphis TN with Memphis AR, when it opens will be one of very few bike and pedestrian friendly crossings of the Mississippi River.

Annual Meeting 2015 - Rosemary Marshall

The East TN chapter will be hosting the 2015 Annual Meeting. Because TTA has outgrown the small conference center in Townsend, and we like the Smokies, the chapter is looking at conference centers in the Pigeon Forge area. Also, looking at weekend dates in November as the hotel/conference room rates drop quite considerably after October 31.

J. R. Tate - J.R.

This will be J.R.'s last Board meeting. J.R. has been the chapter chair for Clarksville for the last 7 or 9 years and wanted to thank the Board for their leadership and support.
