This will be a short hike-picnic and swim in Morgan Creek. Bring a picnic lunch. Watermelon will be served by your hosts." Wg'll have more complete details next month.

Gordon Newland reports that the meeting place for the Sept. 11 hike will be at the restaurant in Bean Gap on Highway U. S. 25E north of Knoxville.

This trip will be on the "unconstructed" Tpail of the Lonesone Pine.

There was a small turnout for the June 24 meeting of the Nachville Chapter of TTA, which was attended by the Editor. TTA member Dave Stidham recreation planner for the Nashville District, Corps of Engineers, gave an interesting slide program on Corps activities in recreation, conservation and trails. Dave will lead a hike for Middle Tennessee members Saturday, July 31 on the Bear Wallow Gap Trail on the Cordell Hull Project near Carthage. The group will meet at 9:00 a.m. CDT at the information center of the Cedar Creek Recreation Area at Defeated, Tenn., on State Route 85 north of Carthage.

Secretary Evelyn Tretter and Evan Means met with Dr. Philip Lavely of the University of Tennessee at Martin and Dick Cottrell, recreation services supervisor for the Land Between the Lakesm on May 29 to discuss the regional trails conference. At the end of the day we had outlined the complete pregram, delegated duties, and came up with half a dezen sponsors (more or

less).

The conference will be devoted to reports of trail activities in the Southeast by government and private organizations and discussion of the problems involved in implementing a trails system. Sponsors will include TTA, Kentucky Trails Association, LBL, BOR, State Parks Division, and UTM. TTA and KTA will be co-hosts. UTM will handle printing, registration, and other miscellaneous chores. BOR will mail invitations and help with planning. Evan Means is program chairman and Evelyn Tretter will coordinate "Show and Tell". Other members of TTA and KTA will be called on for various jobs. The invitations will go out about the end of July.

The program will include an ico-breaker reception and "Show and Tell" on Thurdday, panel discussions and a trip to Land Between the Lakes with buffelo supper on Friday; more panels on Saturday, with free time in the afternoon for bull sessions, and a banquet.
